




And ye must stand to be judged of your works, whether they be good or evil; and also that ye may believe the gospel of Jesus Christ, which ye shall have among you;



God's glory manifests and reveals His love.

What is the meaning of the word "Glory"?

Funk & Wagnalls, New Standard Dictionary of the English Language, under "glory", gives the religious symbolic meaning as follows:

The complete representation of an emanation of light from the person of a sanctified being;

the quality of being radiant or shining; brilliancy brightness; luster; as the glory of the sun;

Glory is the general term for the aureola and the nimbus"—aureola being the halo or ring round the sun, and nimbus being the sun-disc.

Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. [Isaiah 60:1]

The sun shall be no more thy light by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give light unto thee; but the Lord shall be unto thee an everlasting light, and thy God thy glory.



Thy sun shall no more go down; neither shall thy moon withdraw itself; for the Lord shall be thine everlasting light, and the days of thy mourning shall be ended.





These all shall bow the knee, and every tongue shall confess to him who sits upon the throne for ever and ever;



he who can not abide the law of a Telestial Kingdom, cannot abide a Telestial Glory:


